Comprehensive and Progressive Agreement for Trans-Pacific Partnership Chapter 25 – Regulatory Coherence

Pursuant to CPTPP Article 25.3: Scope of Covered Regulatory Measures, Peru has determined that the scope of its covered regulatory measures is as follows.

For Peru, a regulatory measure means a measure of general application related to any matter covered by this Agreement adopted by regulatory agencies with which compliance is mandatory. As Peru is currently on the first phase of the implementation of Regulatory Impact Analysis, for the purposes of this Chapter, Peru will consider as covered regulatory measures the following regulatory and administrative regulations:

- Administrative procedures and regulations of the National Superintendence of Sanitation Services (SUNASS)
- Regulation of Infractions and Sanctions by Supervisory Agency for Investment in Transportation Infrastructure for Public Use (OSITRAN)
- General Tariff Regulations for Transportation
- Regulations for Attention to Claims and Dispute Resolution
- General Supervision Regulation
- Regulation of Users of Transport Infrastructures for Public Use
- Complementary Provisions to the Regulation for the Contracting of Supervisory Companies by OSITRAN
- Regulation of Contribution
- Regulation for the payment of Remuneration to the State of OSITRAN
- Framework Regulation for Access to Public Transport Infrastructure
- Regulations on Electric Rates
- Transportation Rates
- Distribution of Natural Gas through pipeline networks
- Transport rates of liquid hydrocarbons by pipelines
- Tariff regulation procedures by Supervisory Agency for Investment in Energy and Mining (OSINERGMIN)
- Resolutions that set the electricity sales rates
- Resolutions that set the New Replacement Value
- Resolutions that set the Added Value of Distribution
